

# Complete School Supplies Checklist

A national planning guide with grade-level examples from a 2026-2027 district list. Confirm the current school and teacher list before buying.

Source note: Grade-level quantities in the example sections are based on the Norman Public Schools 2026-2027 list provided by a caregiver. Brand names were described as preferred for quality, not universally required.

## Before you shop

Use the official district and school list whenever possible. Teacher requests, device connections, exploratory classes, and schedule changes can add supplies after school starts.

- ☐ Confirm the student's current school, grade, and class schedule.
- ☐ Ask which supplies the school provides and which must be kept by the student.
- ☐ Confirm whether headphones require 3.5 mm, USB-C, USB-A, Bluetooth, or another connection.
- ☐ Ask the student about backpack, color, folder, and water-bottle preferences.
- ☐ Buy a small first-day set if enrollment happens before the final schedule is available.
- ☐ Keep receipts until teachers confirm the list.
- ☐ Check for school, agency, community, or donation programs before paying out of pocket.

## Elementary technology and donation notes

- ☐ Optional personal headphones or earbuds with a 3.5 mm jack for district curriculum use.
- ☐ Optional classroom donation: disinfecting wipes.
- ☐ Optional classroom donation: hand sanitizer.
- ☐ Optional classroom donation: tissues.

## Middle school, grades 6-8

Basic supplies students may keep across classes. Additional items may be requested when classes or schedules change.

- ☐ 2 packages notebook paper, approximately 150 sheets each
- ☐ 1 package pencils
- ☐ 4 composition or spiral notebooks
- ☐ 4 folders, any type
- ☐ 1 package colored pencils, 12 count
- ☐ 2 highlighters, any color
- ☐ 2 black or blue pens
- ☐ USB-C headphones or earbuds

### Suggested math supplies, verify course placement

- ☐ Basic four-function calculator for some 6th- and 7th-grade math classes
- ☐ TI-30XS MultiView scientific calculator for pre-algebra or as requested

### Optional donation items

- ☐ Disinfecting wipes
- ☐ Boxes of tissues

# High school alternative-program example

Example based on the 2026-2027 Dimensions Academy High School Program list supplied by a caregiver.

- ☐ 1 clear or standard 1.5-inch three-ring binder
- ☐ 3 pocket folders
- ☐ 2 packages of 12 pre-sharpened #2 pencils
- ☐ 2 packages black pens
- ☐ 2 containers hand sanitizer
- ☐ 2 containers antibacterial wipes
- ☐ 4 boxes tissues

## First-day backpack check

- ☐ School identification or enrollment documents only when directed by the school or case team.
- ☐ Notebook or folder for temporary assignments.
- ☐ Pencils and pens.
- ☐ Device and correct charger, if issued.
- ☐ Correct headphones or earbuds.
- ☐ Water bottle if allowed.
- ☐ Lunch or lunch-account information.
- ☐ Transportation plan and trusted adult contact information.
- ☐ Any required medication handled through the school's approved process.
